

BOROUGH OF BALLY
ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 153, WHICH PROVIDES FOR A PER CAPITA TAX UPON EACH RESIDENT AND INHABITANT OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY APPROVED JUNE 25, 1947, P.L. 1145, AS AMENDED.

The BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, Berks County, Pennsylvania hereby ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 153, as amended, is hereby amended to change the levied per capita tax of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) upon each resident and inhabitant of the Borough of Bally eighteen (18) years of age and over, which tax shall be in addition to any other taxes levied and assessed by the Borough of Bally, to Five Dollars (\$5.00).

SECTION 2. All other provisions of said Ordinance No. 153, as amended, are hereby affirmed and re-enacted.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar and only insofar as they affect this act.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally.
