

**ORDINANCE NO. 259**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY,  
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
VACATING AN UNOPENED PORTION OF NORTH THIRD STREET**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Borough of Bally by section 1741 et seq. of the Borough Code (53 P.S. § 46741), the unopened portion of North Third Street being approximately 30 feet wide and approximately 902 feet in length, and lying between a point 132 feet north of the northern legal right-of-way line of Pennsylvania Route 100 (Main Street) and the terminus of North Third Street, and being located wholly within the Borough of Bally, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be invalid by the courts, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, nor the validity of any section or provisions of the Ordinance other than the one so declared.

SECTION 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances which are contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on April 5, 2006.


