

**ORDINANCE # 265**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING BOROUGH ORDINANCES #234 AND #237, "BALLY BOROUGH SEWER USERS REGULATIONS", CHANGING THE POLLUTANT LOCAL LIMITS FOR USERS OF THE SEWER SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bally has adopted a "Pretreatment Program" in conjunction with the operation of its Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the approved "Pretreatment Program" includes an Ordinance known as the "Borough Sewer User Regulations", which sets and regulates local limits for certain known pollutants; and,

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to change the local limits to meet current conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, Borough Council, with the approval of the United States Department of Environmental Protection, does hereby set the following local limits for the below listed pollutants as shown in Ordinance #234, Section 2.4 "Local Limits":

| Antimony | none      |
| Chromium | 4.33 mg/L |
| Copper   | 1.19 mg/L |
| Lead     | 0.55 mg/L |
| Nickel   | 1.51 mg/L |
| Zinc     | 0.76 mg/L |

This Ordinance amends Ordinance #234 and #237 to the extent of changing the local limits for known pollutants only, and does not affect any other part of Ordinance #234.


This Ordinance shall become effective the date first adopted.
