

ORDINANCE 298

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 153 IMPOSING A PER
CAPITA TAX ON RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 1302 of the "Borough Code" (Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. (1965) 1656, No. 581, as amended) Ordinance Number 153 of the Borough of Bally imposing a per capita tax upon each resident and inhabitant of the Borough of Bally eighteen (18) years of age and over, and any amendments thereto is hereby repealed and there shall no longer be a per capita tax within the Borough of Bally.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar and only insofar as they affect this act.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally.


