

ORDINANCE NUMBER 299

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 298 REPEALING THE PER CAPITA TAX ON RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 1302 of the "Borough Code" (Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. (1965) 1656, No. 581, as amended) Ordinance Number 298 of the Borough of Bally repealing Ordinance 153 that imposed a per capita tax upon each resident and inhabitant of the Borough of Bally eighteen (18) years of age and over is hereby REPEALED; Ordinance No. 153 is fully reinstated and the Per Capita Tax is reinstated within the Borough of Bally.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar and only insofar as they affect this act.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally.
