

BOROUGH OF BALLY
ORDINANCE #312

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE # 256 IN PART, WITH RESPECT ONLY TO THE PROVISIONS RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO PAY AMOUNTS DUE AND FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE, AND LEAVING THE REMAINDER OF ORDINANCE #256 IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS TO RATES AND REGULATIONS OF WATER AND SEWER TO PROPERTIES AND ESTABLISHMENTS THEREIN, AND ALL REMAINING PROVISIONS OF THAT ORDINANCE.

The Borough Council of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, hereby ORDAINS as follows:

1. Section 10 of Ordinance 256 of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, enacted on or about the 5th day of July 2005, is hereby amended to add the following subparagraph:

F. The owner of the property served shall, in addition to all other costs, product and services provided under the water and sewer provisions of this Ordinance, and reinstatement and/or reconnection fees, be liable for all filing fees, costs, and expenses, including without limitation all costs for counsel and related professional services in connection with any violations, failures to pay amounts due for costs, product and services, provided by the Borough in connection with water and sewer services. In the event that, pursuant to Pennsylvania law, an enforcement lien is placed upon the property served, the owner shall be liable to the Borough for all filing fees, costs and expenses, including without limitation counsel fees in the actual amount incurred by the Borough for the placement of, reinstatement of and removal of, any such lien placed by or for the benefit of the Borough of Bally and/or the Bally Borough Municipal Authority.

2. Section 13 of Ordinance 256 of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, enacted on or about the 5th day of July 2005, is hereby amended to add the following language:

In addition to, and separate from the preceding provisions of this paragraph, any individual convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall also be subject to the provisions of Section 10 F. of this Ordinance, as additional penalties for such violation.

3. In all other respects, the provisions of Ordinance 256 of 5 July 2005 remain in full force and effect.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect on OCTOBER 1, 2024.
