RESOLUTION 2022-3

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BALLY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
ESTABLISHING FEES OR CHARGES FOR PUBLIC SEWER SERVICE UPON THE OWNERS
OF IMPROVED PREMISES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BALLY AT WHICH A WATER
METER OR METERS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority given to Council by Borough of Bally Ordinance No. 256, Borough Council does hereby establish the fees and charges for sewer service within the Borough of Bally as follows:

SEWER CHARGES

The sewer fees or charges for public sewer service to the owners of improved premises within the Borough of Bally shall be imposed on a quarterly basis and shall be based upon water consumption, as metered, upon the premises during each calendar quarter. Public sewer rates are hereby imposed as follows:

- A. RESIDENTIAL UNITS: For each residential dwelling unit the minimum charge for public sewer service up to 5,000 gallons of water consumption in a quarter... \$181.00 per quarter

For all sewer usage over 5,000 gallons per quarter \$14.00 per each 1,000 gallons

- B. NON-RESIDENTIAL UNITS: For each non-residential unit the minimum charge for public sewer service up to 15,000 gallons of water consumption in a quarter ... \$303.00 per quarter

For all sewer usage over 15,000 gallons per quarter \$14.50 per each 1,000 gallons


- C. The sewer charges to be imposed on account of the discharge of wastes into the public sewer system, which require special treatment, shall be based upon the Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and the total solids content of the sewage in comparison with the content of normal domestic sewage.

The minimum charge for sewer and/or sewer services supplied through any meter must be paid for each quarterly period, or fraction thereof, during which sewer service is available and is turned on for meters serving any residential or non-residential unit, whether or not any sewer is actually used.

These rates shall be effective as of the November 1, 2022 usage period to be billed March 1, 2023.
